



The 12' Gull is based on the Peterborough Canoe Company's outboard motor/ rowboat. The name aptly describes the way the boat perches on the water. This craft is ideal for "messing about in boats"* or for fishing or for the cottage. It can be used as a rowboat or can easily be transformed into a motorboat with a small gas or electric motor. Since it is small in size, the 12' Gull can be used solo (1 set of oarlocks) or is capable of carrying passengers. Its handy size makes it great for young people or adults. Since it is lightweight, it can be easily car topped. Our plans are full sized and detailed and include patterns for all the integral parts which make it an easy motor/ rowboat to build.
