



Over the years, Chestnut had many different versions of the 16' Prospector model. The first and original model had a flattened shallow arch hull with slightly less rocker. This model was less tippy without a load and tracked better on a windy lake. It originated the distinctive sheerline an bow height. The later models became very round bottomed with much rocker which made for a very tippy and hard to track canoe when not heavily loaded. It could be very dangerous for inexperienced paddlers.

Our own model's lines have been taken from Joe Ziemba's own original early model, vintage Chestnut Prospector. It is an ideal canoe for carrying heavy loads and extended canoe trips. This model is beautiful, functional and safe. The 16' Original Chestnut Prospector remains the quintessential wilderness tripping canoe for lake or river travel.
